The 1st Regt. N.Y. Vols. was organized at Elmira Chemung Co. N.Y. and was
 mustered on the 27th day of Oct. 1862. Left Elmira Nov. 18 '62 and reported to Gen
 Banks in N.Y. City. Engaged on Long Island till Dec. 2 '62 then embarked
 on Steam Transport "Northern Light" and arrived at Baton Rouge La. Dec. 17 '62
 Camp was at Baton Rouge till Sept 3 '63 During the time from Dec. 17 '62 to Sept 3 '63
 made a reconnaissance with the troops under command of Gen Banks May 12 '63
 12 '63 marched toward Port Hudson La. Had an engagement at Chanis Store La May
 21 '63 - May 26 '63 marched onto the works of the enemy at Port Hudson La and
 forced part of the besieging force till the enemy surrendered on July 9 '63
 They are forked on Steamer "St. Charles" and landed at Douglassville La was
 in the engagement at Cris's plantation on Bayou La Prouche La July 13 '63
 Returned to camp at Baton Rouge July 30 '63 and Sept 2 '63 embarked on
 Steamer "Seal Banks" which formed part of the expedition to Sabine Pass Texas
 were defeated and Sept 12 arrived at Algiers La. on 15th Sept took cars to Bras
 shear City and from there marched some 200 miles as far as Opelousas La having
 Head Qtrs. at Brashear City - Bistand - Franklin - New Orleans - Ver
 million Ville - Carriou Bayou - Barrenquet Bayou - Barry Landing La
 Hd Qrs at present at Franklin La on return march
