Colonel:

You will hold your command in readiness to move to-morrow morning at daylight to Hickox Landing, on Lake Ponchartrain, where you will find vessels to carry you to Mobile Point, Alabama. You will go by rail to the shell road, and march thence to the Lake. Major M'Entee, Chief Quarter-Master, has gone to the city to make the necessary arrangements for railroad transportation. Your wagons will be sent by the river road without any load, and should be got off as early as possible. It will be well for you to send very early in the morning to Kenner to arrange for a convenient place for loading, which will be done without further orders from here.
