A BILL

Granting an increase of pension to William B. Kinsey.

- 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Secretary of the Interior be, and he is hereby, au-
4 thorized and directed to place on the pension roll, subject to
5 the provisions and limitations of the pension laws, the name
6 of William B. Kinsey, late lieutenant-colonel One hundred
7 and sixty-first Regiment New York Volunteer Infantry, and
8 pay him a pension at the rate of fifty dollars per month in
9 lieu of that he is now receiving.
