Draft in the Third District, Brooklyn. WARDS ONE, TWO AND THREE COMPLETE.

Capt. STEPHEN B. GREGORY, Provost-Marshal of the Third Congressional District, commenced the Draft in the Third District, Brooklyn, at his headquarters, No. 250 Washington-street, Brooklyn, yesterday morning, at 10 o'clock, drafting the quotas of the First, Second and Third Sub-Districts, which are so arranged as to be identical with the Wards indicated by those numerals.

A very large crowd assembled in the immediate vicinity of the building. By direction of Inspector FALK, Capt. JOEL SMITH had stationed a large Police force, both inside and outside of the building, under Sergeants THOMAS J. CORNELL and LAFRAM, of the Forty-first Precinct, who kept admirable order, and exercised power with discretion.

The local militia were also under arms, while the United States troops in large numbers were in proximity to the headquarters. Two companies, C and D, of the gallant Minnesota First volunteers were on guard duty under command of Capt. HERRINGTON, who has served with the regiment under Cois. COMMAN and DANA in every battle which has tried its mettle, and borne himself with the reputation of a thorough soldier in each and all.

The building in which Capt. GREGORY has established his headquarters is an exceedingly small house well known to all Brooklynites as "The Shades," the parlors of which serve as the drafting room, and which were densely and uncomfortably filled. Capt. GREGORY had, with courteous forethought, done all that he could for the Press, but that all was little and the inconvenience was great.

The Enrollment Board of the Third Congressional District is composed of Capt. STEPHEN B. GREGORY, Provost-Marshal; Commissioner, ADAM M. BEERS; Surgeon, NELSON B. NORTH, M. D. MR. HENRY BRIDGEMAN is the Recorder and Mr. BENJAMIN M. CASE the Deputy Provost-Marshal. At a little after 9 A. M. the blind man who was to draw the ballots, Mr. DAVID H. WINTERS, took the oath of allegiance. Mr. WINTERS was formerly a member of the One Hundred and Thirty-sixth New York Volunteers, and while on picket duty at Williamsburgh, Va., was shot through the face, the ball literally taking on both

eyes. Despite this fact, some one in the crowd insisted upon having him done up in a white silk banana, in consequence of which he suffered materially during the day. The sealed boxes were brought up, and Capt. GREGORY announced that the draft of the Third Congressional District would be proceeded with, commencing with the

FIRST SUB-DISTRICT,

of the First Ward, Messrs. BENJ. S. MIDDLEY, R. D. COMBES and C. C. DE BOG were appointed to count the ballots in the box. They reported 226, from which 180 were to be drawn as the quota of the First Ward, with the fifty per cent. additional.

The ballots were then poured into the wheel, while the crowd gave utterance to good natured expressions. The wheel went round, and out came the first ballot, on which was inscribed the name of

ANDREW JOHNSON, No. 11 State-street.

Inspector POLK, Postmaster LINCOLN, Col. NUGENT, Provost-Marshal-General, Capt. MCGEE, of his Staff, and Sheriff CAMPBELL, were among the spectators. Mr. WARING, one of the enrolling officers, was drawn, as were two brothers DUBAZZ, and two persons of Afric descent.
