Y. by W. Lansing for the period of the war years, and mustered into the United States' service on the twenty-third day of November 1861, at Saratoga N. Y., by Maj Sitgreaves, Enrolled as 3^d Corporal and promoted from 1st Sergt to 2^d Lieut May, 1st/63, and was mustered out on expiration of term of service Dec 13/64.
