*3 May 1835 - 1927*

Enlisted in the U.S. service Oct. 1st 1861 as private in Co. I, 77th Regt., N.Y. Vol Infantry to serve three years. The Regt., under the command of Col. James B. Mc Kean, left the State Nov. 28th '61 and served in 3rd Brig., Carneys ~~xxxxxxx~~ <sup>xxDiv. A.P.</sup> later in the 3rd Brig., 2nd Div., 6th Corps A.P. and participated in the following battles:-

Siege of Yorktown Va., April 5th-May 4th '62; Williamsburg May 5th '62; Seven Days Battle June 25th-July 2nd '62; Malverns Hill July 1st '62, Crampton Pass MD Sept 14th '62; Antietam Md. Sept. 17th '62; ~~Fredericksburg~~ Fredericksburg Va. Dec 13th '62; Maryes Heights and Salem Church May 3-4th '63; Gettysburg Pa July 1-3 '63; Mine Run, Va. Nov 26th '63; Wilderness May 5-7 '64; Spottsylvania May 8-24th '64; Petersburg June 15-19th '64; Weldon R.R. June 21-23th '64; Charlestown W.Va., Aug. 21st '64; Winchester, Va. Sept 19th '64; Fishers Hill Sept 22nd '64; Cedar Creek Oct. 19th '64; <sup>P</sup> Was taken prisoner at Spottsylvania Va. May 10th '64; and escaped on way to Richmond on the 16th in the night and after seven days of wandering reached the Union lines ~~at~~ it being three weeks before he rejoined his Regt.

Was promoted Corporal, Sergeant then to 2nd Lieutenant, *May 1 1863*. Was mustered out of the United States Service and honorably discharged as 2nd Lieutenant December . ~~1864~~ 1864 by reason of ~~his~~ the expiration of his term of service.

*married Lydia Ann Andrews in 1866 and had 3 children for her death named Emanuel Beckwith in 1909*
