Dear Sir

I am informed that I  
came out a prisoner. And I would like your help  
a little. If you remember the year and month  
I was sent Home I was sent Home while I was  
under McClellan. And it was, I think when I was  
at or near the White House I know that I was put on  
board of a Hospital Boat and Landed in New York I  
was then sent North to my Home. It was the time that  
all sick was sent Home without furlough. Clunk  
Hayes was with me at the time. Able bearing Home  
a little time Hay was a Order come out for all  
Soldiers Home with out furlough to report to Col  
Went in Hollisburgh and if not well enough to go  
back to their Regt. they would extend their furlough  
I reported to Hollisburgh was examined and I got  
a furlough of 30 days extended now I wish to find out  
the year and as near as I can the month I would  
like also to know the amount of Bounty we got when  
we re-enlisted will you please help me and anything  
I can do for you I will do it I have not seen any of the  
boys in a long time I have once from M. E. Merrill  
he was in Malcho and well I lost all of my letters and  
discharge by fire. Please give me all the information

You can on this Hoping this will find you  
I'll also family
