First days fight over. All well. We are so far very successful. Probably the brunt of the coming fight will fall on the 5th Corps

Safe as yet. As I expected yesterdays fighting fell to the share of the 5^{th} Corps. They were rather roughly handled but are now fast. We cant be driven except by a total defeat of the 5^{th} C which holds the left flank.
