Washington D.C. Aug. 15th [1863]

Dear Father

The Alexandria¹ boat leaves in a short time and I have time for a few words only. I will write to the family at length when I reach the Regt. I received four on the pay this morning and enclose a draft for \$ 350. Expect to reach Regt without any difficulty. My arm is <u>entirely</u> healed and strong as ever.
