

Division Hospital near Kellys Ford, Virginia

December 10, 1863

Dear Parents & Friends at Home,

I write you a few lines again to day [sic] thinking you would be anxious to hear from me. we have not moved since I wrote you last and things indicate that we will stay here some time but do not know.

I think I am improving some and think I could get around a considerable if my feet were so I could. While we were on the march I chilled my feet and froze my toes. They are swelled so I cannot wear my boots and pain me very much. I want you to send me a bottle of that Ointment of Dr. Weeds. if I remember right it is recomended [sic] for sore feet. if that is not the medicine I wish you would send me something that is good for frozen feet as soon as you can. you can send it by mail without much cost.

I have nothing farther to write to day [sic].

I want to hear from Home often and will write in return as often as I can.

I hope you are all well at Home and things moving favorably.

With this I will close.
