

Porters Corners nov. 2<sup>nd</sup> 1862

Dear Brother

I now sit down to answer your letter which I received Thursday I was glad to hear from you and to hear that you was well we are all well at present I had a letter from John last night and he was well and he said that he <sup>thought</sup> he should come home before long I received that money that you sent me when you was in new york they are a going to draft the 10 of this month I had a letter from Theodore ~~two~~ two weeks ago last night and he is well mother sends her love to you and says that you must be a good boy and have the war to an end and come home as soon as you can nancy martin is dead she is buried to day no more this time only right as soon as you get this from your affectionate brother George F Hill
