nov 10th 1862

Dear Brother

I now sit down to answer your letter which i received last night it found us all well at present Maather has been sick a gain but is better now I had a bout 25 bushells of potatoes i think i have got a bout hay ~~now~~ enough to winter the cow the pig is getting pretty good i shall kill him in a few days Franks Hewitts baby is dead is is ~~now~~ bared to morrow i am to work for John weaver this week i hav had a letter from Brit and Theodore and they are all well i got that money it came through all right i have writen to you before

i guess it is about time for me to
close for i have got to write two more
letters to night mother sends her love
to you no more this time only write
as soon as you get this this is from
your brother George F^r Hill

we have had a quite a snow storm up
here and it snowed under ground morning
potatoes and there is a good deal of corn out
yet
