It is with pleasure that I sit down to answer your kind letter which I received last night it found me in the best of health and I hope this will find you the same we received the bad news of Lincoln's death yesterday the flag was lowered to half mast and it is at half mast to day and the gun boat fires a gun every half hour

it is so bad that  
he should be murdered  
when the rebellion is  
so near at an end  
we have got old Lee and  
his whole army and ere  
this reaches you I hope

and Beauregard it is  
a very fine morning  
and every thing looks  
very nice the war is  
about over I guess I  
shall enlist in the  
regulars I was a little
