1867

Dear Brother

I now sit down to answer
your letter which we received
Thursday it is all well and
I hope that this will find
you the same I should
I have written before but
I did not go home till
yesterday and then I got
your letter I dont know
how long I shall stay
here he gives me the same
that he did you it is a
raining here to day John
weaver has got his house
up Chaly Lathams wife
has got a boy old granny
Latham is sick and they
dont expect she will live
Jane is with mother yet

I wil take a gun and shoot
all that is in favor of
the war in stead of them
that opposes it. Father
sends his love to you and
says that you must be
a good boy I nut got
time to write any thing
more fore it is a hard
mail time we good by
you must nut writ for
me to write for I dont
go home only once a
week write soon this is
from your brother
