Fort schuyer Jan 28 1804 My Dear Mather It is with pleasure that I take this apportunity of wit ing to you I arrived here all safe and sound a bout 10 clock to day as we started from schowedady last mig ht a bout seven volack we got to albany and there we marched a crost the iver and took the cars for new york where we arrived about seven or clock and then we man ehed down to the river and there we had to staye until half fast ten then we took the steam boat for fort schufler where we serived at one as before memberoned it is quite a sight to see the ships a long the harber
