Dear Mother

I now take my pen in hand to write you a few lines to let you know that i am well in rate a few days ago but i didn't know the name of the place i wrote in my other letter about the fight i have heard that the rebs fell back 20 miles but not from any reliable source there hasn't quite so much musick hear to day as there was at pleasant hill a week ago to day you could hear the old hum shells go with with but it wasn't very pleasant musick after

All I had in rather
hear a Piano 2 to one i
hear me killed 4 of their
men their one of ours well
now I will tell you what
we had for dinner we had
Pork & beans i have eat to
much & we have got some
flower & butter & Skiger
& to night we will have
Some Pancakes well

Dear Mother & I dont
I know much news to write
but i will rite as
often as i can but then
since we left Franklin
we have been out ^{the} go all
the time we have laid hear
most a week my quard out
on picket day before yesterday
