June the 12 1864.

Dear Mother I now take
my pen in hand to write a
few lines to let you know that
I am well and I hope these
few lines will find you the same
there is something the matter
with the mailing of your letters
or else you dont write I havent heard
no mail for the three last mails
but I guess I will get one in a
few days too day is Sunday and
I have been too work all day a
cleaning up my gun and straps
we had a General Review yesterday
and it Showed before we got
back and so you see we got our
guns wet and so we have too work
too too day too clean them up there
is no news of importance too

Write the rebs dont bother
us much now we have
got our camp fixt up bully
I have got a good bunk and
good blankets and a good feather
pillow it is a rebble bed piler
but it lays verry good indeed
I am acting Sargent now ~~to~~
and as soon as there is a
vacancy I will be Promoted
i will Put 10 dollars in this letter
and if you get it i will send
some more ~~in~~ when i hear from
you this one was Paid last
thursday well Dear mother
I dont know of any thing
more at Present only write as
soon as you get this So Good
bye ~~so~~ This From your affectionate
