June the 14 1864

Dear Mother I take my pen in hand this morning too rite a few lines too let you know that i am well and i hope when this reaches you it will find you in good health I rote too you on the 12 and put \$10.00 dollars in the letter and yesterday i sent \$25.00 dollars by Adams Adams Express you will send too Saratoga for Pitt the Charges is all paid and i want you too rite as soon as you get this and let me know weather

you get the \$10 dollars  
that i sent in the letter  
Hiram Mosher got a letter  
in the last mail and he  
said that they had heard  
that I was killed in some  
of the battles but you can  
tell them i am alive and  
kicking i wish you would  
send me a few Postage Stamps  
Stamps they are scarce here  
and rite what luck you have  
about that matter i am  
anxious too hear the weather  
is nerry nice hear now it has  
been nerry dry hear until this  
month and this month it has  
rained Every day until yesterday  
I guess i wont send this until  
the mail comes in it will come  
in <sup>in</sup> a day or two June the 10<sup>th</sup> 1864  
I now take my pen in hand too

Try and finish this as  
the mail has not come in yet  
i Still Remain well and too  
day am quite busy as i am acting  
orderly but want this too go out  
too day for the mail leaves  
Newark on Saturday and i  
want this too get there in time  
too go out as you will get it some  
days sooner i expect the mail  
every day now i think you will  
get the letter that i wrote the  
12 and this one at the same time  
I hope you will get the money all  
safe there has three men died  
since we left Washington and too  
got there Discharge well i dont  
know of any thing more at present  
So I will bid you good by hoping  
i will get a letter in a day or two  
Write soon as you get this From  
your Affectionate Son Seth Hill

We was out on a forage Train  
the other day and we got a ~~to~~ 10  
Loads of corn the old reb  
didnt like it much but  
all he will have too doo is  
too take the Sees of it
