Sept. the 27. 1864.

Dear Mother

At. I have got to my regt  
Again i will Embrace the perz  
Opportunities to rite and let  
you know how i get along i  
am well and hope this will  
find you the same i left the  
Hospital on the 13 and got up to  
my Regt on the 27 our boys  
did cut up pretty hard and  
had thear waist's killed and  
wounded out of our regt i will  
tell you who was wounded out  
of our regt <sup>Co</sup> Corp'l Darman in  
the foot Corp'l Seanehart in the  
Neck Heritage in the arm Adam  
Niles in the cheek Peter Moore  
leg amputated George E Hutchens  
in the thigh Edward Vanransler

in the side and none  
killed they have <sup>since</sup> the rebs  
Bats, i can tell you we have  
taken any quantity of prisoners  
and Cannons and they still are  
bringing in prisoners they was  
all demoralized and run away to  
get away well Mother  
i dont suppose we will  
stay here long and i am anxious  
to hear from Ned and all the  
rest and if you can do any  
thing to hurry up those papers  
do it and dont delay no time  
i got that letter with the  
\$22 dollars in i dont  
think of any more at  
present only write soon  
we are 36 miles  
from Stanton Harpers Ferry  
i will by bringing you all  
good by
