To Eat Such as it is and we get
a very good gratuity I Dont see
any sight for getting home yet
you Redent make any Calculations
on my comming and then if do not
come there will be no Disapointment
and if I do come ~~on~~ it will be a
Disapointment I will come as soon
as there is any chance Mr Hodges
Says as soon as there is any chance
he will get me off I think there
will be a chance before a great
while I am acting orderly yet
And I like it better then I do
doing guard duty for i am in
my Quarters Every Night I dont
think I will send this out until
I get a letter from Helen
Again for I dont know whether
you are at home or at the
Vilege Village of Saratoga
we have had some cool weather
near in the Adirondack Shenandoah

Valley But we are pretty
well prepared for it so let it
micker it havt only 10 months
more then the small number
that is left of the old stock
will be at liberty as it is
about time for me to call the
Roll and Report I will be
Bidding you good Night and will
Write before I send this out
Good Morning as there was
some good news Rummard around
camp last Evening the was that
Mr Grant had taken Richmond
But we hardly as credit the
Story but we hope that it is
so and now i think the only
way may far we do get home
is for ~~I~~ to have somebody
Telegraph to me that you are very
very sick if we should stay
long here i think that i could
get home in the course of the winter

But as things stand
Nam they won't grant us well
Furlough & I have got some
money that i wish you
had but hear is no express
that i can send it by and
don't like the plan of sending
in letters for it is not safe
I will close bidding you good
