1863

Dear Mother

It is  
with pleasure that I sit  
down to answer your kind  
letter it found me well  
and I hope that this will  
find you the same It is  
fine weather down here now  
I am orderly to say there  
is four picked out very morning  
at guard mount one is excused  
from all duty they are four  
of the clearest men I  
rather get excused A or  
am orderly very time I am  
on guard I should have  
tryed and got a furlough

if I had not ben a  
way from the company so  
long last summer I think  
moris is a flying high  
and I think he will  
lite low I give my love  
to mr sessions & and mr  
mills folks I may be  
home be fore spring but  
you A need not look  
for me till I come  
any way I dont know  
of any thing more to  
write this time write soon  
and all the news I  
wish dray and sue mitch  
jay from your son
