My Dear Uncle

Well I am seated here

our usual good health and spirits and  
Father also is gaining but rather slowly  
but I think he will get along now if  
we are careful of him.

I am very glad that you returned  
home safe and am also glad of your  
promotion and wish I were there to  
see your stripes on you or you were  
at home so that I could. I would not  
care which

Well I hope you do not believe it

But we went to Ballston Spa with  
that terrible surprise party last Thursday  
evening and had a good time I did  
at any rate and I guess the rest did  
Cousin Carr's people were up to our  
house the same day

Frankie Davis sends her best resps  
respect to you and says she has and  
been to a party since that time we started  
to Ballston she had a sore throat so she
