May the : - 93 /18084 Dear Mother I now take my pen in hand to write you a few lines to let you know know that I am well are got hear yesterday at 12 a clock & mentinto cump on the hank of the mississippi me left Alexandria on the 12 & gat to Simsport on the 17 Stayed thear until the 19 and then one crost the Catholite River and Soo on to the Missippi mississippi Reiner and and marched 25 miles down the river owhere out are now now Encampe Encamped how long me Shall Stay hear if me Stray hear a meek me shall do well but me may stay I hear 3 months but i think me will go back to Hemarkeans me had Same Sharp fighting coming hack the relig Tride to Stap us at marksville but me Soon made them Skedadle the next marring me Started at Dy day light or me marched about a mile & then me farmed a line of battle & Sour batry apend with on the Rely there was Same lough Canonacting for Something like 4 hours the rebs Shot mighty clust to us with thear Shells but me dident have a man hust in our Bigiment but me Soon Made them It Skedadle again it mas fun In to dee the gray backs run they ment paster then Double Denich time To the marched I Miles in line of battle me throwld down Some rail pence for the rebs we owhen me come to a pence it mans

But long before it lay plat when the 16 core got within 5 miles of Simsport the Rechts came up in I thear Rear & General Smith turned across around & give them a pluging and drove them back and quite a lot of Frisoners but I don't know how many Thear was to day that we only got 2 thirds Recitions but me got along first rate for thear mas lots of Holy & Other Hens & turkers & Blenty of anions and Same Eggs I ment into one house and gall a dozen of Eggs and took a hen In me of had had a good Supper and I got a mice fat Sheep and f got Honey Sic on yes and I got a mice falm leaf Hat and a five dollar confederate bill ega clean Shirt mine being Somewhat & dirty & will Stood you the bill & Some needles theft Juan mill dee in the Tapers of our fighting long before This reaches you do thede is no just of my wiling any thing more about it So i will rite about blackbeles, I have been to day and got three grants & if i can get Some ingen meal is will have and on a bag fuding to moron the meather is very marm hear they have new That thatalyes, flas ledice bell and all kind of garden Sauce is fit for use me have marched atunda Dix Hundred miles Since the 13 of march and have done Some fighting in the bargain me have had a dretty Hard march one day coming from Grandlewill To Alexandria me marched 40 miles me sturted at 3 a clock in the morning and Murched until half hast the Eleven I make one masent tired no I gness prot but me majent long before me mas into bed but our beds masent like a pether hed but and sleep first rate as well as i Ever diel

In I Good bed I Got a letter Errom you gesterday morning dated the 11 & ap Apr & one from Hellen clated, the 26 ap April and one from fred dated the 6 of April I Heave Feate quite as number of letters that you have not got for the Resh Captured one of or to apour mails on the Red Hiver while Soing and Destroyed the backs of onas desteds brother Has Inlisted into our Compan The got to the Reg gestedy Rite & let Me know what luck you hay about what you sate met have bomenced of to missiher my letters do you will know owhen thear is one midding our fighting is over for the Tresent thear is how yourse of Relof nerry near hear thear is Some Suriles will try & rite as opten as i Can can but when me are all the time on the ga I don't have much Chance to rite Well I, don't know as i can rite any more, for it is hard work & guess you will think do by the riting tell annie that The Had better wait until the & The ald Solgers gets home for they under Stand conting and mashing first rate Sive My Soveto Small close by bidding you good by Bite Sown Ta His Gear mother Send some a Taper We draw full Boutons mon Theth Hall Direct as before
