that seventy five dollars
that you sent me I got
things that I needed
I was a bout three weeks
~~in~~ in getting to my
company and I see rather
hard times we encountered
heavy storm when I
expected very minute to
go over board and gain
a watery grave but the
lord took care of me and
he is able to protect me
still dont worry a bout
me for I think the war
will soon be over it never
looked so favorable as it
does now I have bin
in over a year and the

other two years will soon
pass over if I have to
stay my time out but
I dont think I shall
have to what is the
general opinion of the
people up there a bout
butler the best as we
soldiers call him I
am glad he has been
relieved several of our
boys are prisoners now
I had all my money
stolen the other day
but I had got a bout
every thing that I
needed I lost all of my
cloths to the hospital
so that I had to buy
and it has cost me
a bout a hundred

dollars write now
mitch our tapes was this
year I have bought
me another watch it
is a good one show
does your watch get
a long I could not get
a long with out one
write soon from your
son
