Fort Fisher South of Petersburgh Va March the 5th 1885 My Dear Mather having Just residered a letter from Ann Written helwary the 26 th in answer to the one that I Wrate to you correctime ago I hasten to per you. a few lines to imparm you that my health is good & I hape This Will find you in good health also I Was glad to hear that sette had been home on furlow par he has been away a long time from home & he Wanted to bee you & the rest of the folks & ev do I & prehaps I can in the course of a few months more I say prehaps but if the land spares my life until my term of versies expires I shall visit Garataga that is only sie months & three days more

& I mean to see my priends as boon as I can par I have been a Baldier long enough to eatisfing me I know What they have to endure but I have had it very easy for a vallier although We have been in the field most of of the time for the past year & have been in two hard fanght battles but The lard has brought me through thus far all rite & how thankful I am far it here We are in bight of The relats camps & When out on ficket come times We are only a pew rads from their lines near enough to talk With eachather & they come & We chap our Wood that We burn on the picket lines together they are friendly & Want to have this and cruel War came to a close they are deserting & comming into our times every day some times 15 ar 20 at a time the other day they drove

in a six mule team than Was six men me five in the Wagon & one on the mules & driving they made as though they got beared & could not stop them until they got inside of our picket lines the Johneys I tood & looked as though they there amased to bee them & never fired a gun at them We have all of the daty to do that they can elick on us We are on duty every day quard fichet ar patigue We come aff one morning & go on duty again the next morning next morning I have not been Christopher in four or five days but he Was Well then I have not heard from the other boys beth don't Write & Whate to him the day that Christapher clarted for home but he dont answer it John has not Written in a long time

I Want to hear from him 00 The may know Whare he is The Weather is very good here now but We have had a good deal of rain for the last Week but it is not myddy here far the Soil is bandy & the rain boaks up quick Now I don't know us 3 have any thing more to While this time I Will bring my letter to a close by Bidding. you Good Bye for the present haping to hear from you been I remain your ever Affectionate Gon Erastus .
