March the 25<sup>th</sup> 1863.

Dear Mother

I now take my pen  
in hand to write you a few lines to  
let you know that I am well  
and do let you know that I am not  
crazy the letter you speak of  
was not int. I intended for a  
letter I wrote a letter at the same  
time that I put that in the office  
after I got the letter rate I thought  
that I should write a little on the  
Draft and I also wrote some verses  
that I think would be appropriate  
to some of our young ladies of  
Greenfield So you see that I am  
not mad and as my Head rate and  
let me know if you got the letter  
or not I put the 10 dollars in that

Funny letter as you called  
it is intended to put the money  
in the other letter But i guess  
it was a good mistake if you  
did not get the letter I guess it will  
now tell you about the tramp that  
we took yesterday we left camp at  
5 o'clock in the morning and marched  
20 miles to a place called Snickers  
gap we hadn't been there long before  
we saw 17 rebels but they was across  
the Shenandoah River we exchanged a  
few shots but without any effect  
they run to far off and we could  
not cross the river we stade  
there all night and this morning  
before day break we started to  
towards camp confiscating all the  
horses that we could see we  
would take them right off from  
the wagons we got into camp  
at 2 o'clock to day we marched  
like the Devil and our feet got

Same here as it has  
been some time since we have  
Marched any when i got to  
camp i found a letter from  
you and ann well Dear Mother  
As i am some tired to night and  
to morrow is Sunday so i will wait  
until Morning before i finish  
This; So Good Night

Dear the 26<sup>th</sup> 1865

well as we have got through with  
Inspection i will finish this letter &  
I am well to day I will tell you  
what we had for dinner we all  
had catfish and Potatoes i may  
damn to Harpers Ferry one day last  
week and i sent my overcoat to  
Saratoga and bid the express on it  
So you can send down by somebody  
that it is going and get it back no  
wont hear only we havent got a coach  
Spar but it wont last long we  
have had some brutal weather since

it snowed a little here yesterday  
I will close by saying that I  
got those stamps  
and by Rite soon
