is with pleasure that

your letter was but it  
dated a way long in  
february it <sup>was</sup> over a month  
a coming I don't know  
where the boys are that  
enlisted when I did  
there is not one of  
them left in the  
regiment there is not  
a man in the regme<sup>nt</sup>  
that I knew before

I enlisted we are having  
fine times here now  
I shall not enlist  
for the present I dont  
know of much more  
to write this time  
dont write till you  
hear from me a gain  
for na knowing where  
we shall be good by  
from your brother
