Julen cet the 8 th 1865 My Dear Mother after so long a deley I thought that I Would Write you a few lines to let you know that I have not forgatten you by any means & to letyou know that We are all Well but Aretheusa whe has not been Well since We come home but she has been so as to be around the house most of the time & she thinks that she Will be better next Week When the got to exherecteday We stoped to Martha & gat dinner her little boy This sick so she could not go With us to egracuse the got to Duniels about sundown that night & The found hate no better than she Was When We

left there & I even Dan last teurday Night he said that she Mas no better We found every thing in good order When We got home to the Children Was glad to see us get home they Was both to Mr Gordons Whare We left Loyal Mr Sordon Was over here in less than an hour after he see us come home for me to go to Work & I have Worked every day but one that has been fare Weather that day We Went up to Woleatt We found the fulk all Well don't sally Erastus Widow & he Was quite complaining but so as to be around the house Mother Grandy Was Well & she told me When I throte to send her love to you Well it has rained every day but one this month that Has friday it rains yet to day

So I have improved the time in Writing this is my third letter to day I have Written to John & to Dan I Wrate to D. & Loutham the first Gunday after the got home but have not heard anything from them yet now I don't Want you to Wait so long as they have done before you Write for We Want to hear from you to know how you all get along & if eith has got home get Well Dear mother as it is getting most bed time I must close my letter for this time dretheuse & the Children sends their love to you Write Goon So good bye for this time from your ever loving & affectionate son Crastus.
