Augusta Aug. 19th 1865.

Dear Father

I wrote you on the 16th inst by Mr. Miles who kindly offered to carry a letter to you. I sent by him one hundred dollars (\$100) & <u>also paid</u> the draft I drew in his favor for fifty dollars (\$50). I think our accounts are all right now & I have (\$100) one hundred dollars in your hands. I do not know when I will get any more money & thought I would send that much home for safe keeping.

I am glad to hear that Edward has arrived home in safety. I miss him very much & hope my time will soon come to go home too. I expect we will leave here about the middle of October if not sooner.

The weather is delightful at present. I am in the enjoyment of excellent health & spirits & hope all at home are likewise. I must close if I want to catch the mail.
