Public notice is hereby given, in pursuance of orders this day received from the President of the United States, that a draft will be made, commencing at 16 o'clock, A. M., Thursday, 23d inst., at the Court House, in the city of Auburn, for two thousand two hundred and sixty-two men, this being the quota assigned to the 24th Congressional District of New York, under the act of Congress approved March 3d, 1863.
